



The 8th UAE International Conference on Antimicrobial Resistance (ICAMR 2025) commenced with a recitation of the Holy Quran, setting a respectful and solemn tone for the event. This was followed by the Inaugural Address delivered by the esteemed Guest of Honor, His Excellency Dr. Hussain Abdulrahman Al Rand, Assistant Undersecretary for Public Health and Chairman of the National Committee for the Implementation of the International Health Regulations and Prevention of Pandemics at the Ministry of Health and Prevention. Dr. Al Rand represented His Excellency Abdul Rahman Mohammed Al Owais, Minister of Health & Prevention of the United Arab Emirates.

In his address, Dr. Al Rand underscored the critical global threat posed by antimicrobial resistance (AMR), which the World Health Organization has identified as one of the top ten public health threats worldwide. He emphasized the UAE's strong commitment to a **One Health approach**, in alignment with the UN's 2024 declaration. Highlighting the importance of enhanced surveillance, improved diagnostics, increased public awareness, and responsible antibiotic use, he outlined the Ministry's strategic initiatives that align with global standards and are supported by the nation's leadership. These efforts aim to secure sustainable health outcomes and strengthen global preparedness. The conference was praised as a key platform for fostering knowledge exchange and promoting innovation in the fight against AMR.

Following the inaugural address, Dr. Najiba M. Abdulrazzaq, Chairperson of the Conference, delivered a warm welcome to the distinguished guests and participants. Reflecting on the progress since the 7th International Conference, Dr. Abdulrazzaq emphasized the escalating global challenge of AMR and its far-reaching consequences for public health systems, economic stability, and modern medical practices. Dr. Najiba Abdul Razzaq, consultant internal medicine and President of the conference, said that lecturers warned against taking antibiotics as soon as they feel respiratory symptoms, or coughs, except by prescription of a doctor, because more than 90% of these cases are caused by viruses.

Antibiotics will not eliminate them, on the contrary, they harm their user because they promote antibiotic resistance in the resistant and increase the risk of contracting resistant bacteria.

Participants in the conference stressed the importance of raising awareness of the correct use of antibiotics, which will pose a major challenge to health policymakers, as the lack of awareness increases the ability of pathogenic bacteria and infections to resist antibiotics, making them useless and threatening the medical development that the world is witnessing.




